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Jerome High School Address & Directions (PLEASE FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS NOTED BELOW AND DO NOT RELY SOLELY ON GPS. FOR RETURNING ATHLETES, THIS IS A NEW ROUTE COMPARED TO PREVIOUS YEARS.)

Jerome High School, 8300 Hyland-Croy Road, Dublin, OH 43016

- From U.S. Route 33/State Route 161 – take the Post Road/Plant City Road Exit and turn right onto Post Road
- Take the first left onto Hyland-Croy Road/Liggett Road and continue on Hyland-Croy Road
- At the traffic circle, take the first right onto Mitchell-Dewitt Road/Brand Road
- Turn left into the Dublin Jerome High School main parking lot

What Athletes Should Bring

Athletes will receive performance apparel; however, we highly recommend you bring the following clothing and/or items. A **Mouth Guard IS MANDATORY** – a Battle mouthpiece will be provided to each athlete and extras may be purchased on-site. **All linemen should also bring their own helmet, if possible.** Each athlete must also bring a gym bag containing: shorts, t-shirt, socks, towel, plastic football cleats (no metal cleats allowed), slides and running/workout sneakers – as well as a pen and notepad (for the classroom sessions).

Apparel

During registration you will receive your bag of FBU Top Gun apparel. Please wear your FBU apparel during the camp, and be sure to give your bag (with your remaining gear) to your parent(s)/guardian(s) or secure it in your vehicle.

Athletic Trainers – Sports Medicine at Nationwide Children’s Hospital
